Firmware updates are regularly posted on the Cisco website. These updates may include bug fixes and functionality enhancements to the router. If you are experiencing problems with your router, you may upgrade or re-flash the firmware to fix them.

IMPORTANT: Before proceeding with the upgrade, your computer must have an active Internet connection. It is strongly recommended that you use a wired computer when upgrading the router's firmware.

It is also important for you to determine the model number of your router to identify which set of instructions will be suitable for your concern. For instructions on getting your router's model number, click <u>here</u>. Below is the list of wired and wireless routers with their corresponding firmware file format:

DEALING WITH A ZIPPED FILE FORMAT

For older Linksys routers, the downloadable firmware format is usually in a zipped file form.

Step 1:

Close Internet Explorer or Safari.
